this book is the outcome of a nato advanced research workshop on the eastern mediterranean as a laboratory basin for the assessment of contrasting ecosystems that was held in kiev ukraine march 23 27 1998 the scientific rationale of the workshop can be summarized as follows the eastern mediterranean is the most nutrient impoverished and oligotrophic large water body known there is a well defined eastward trend in nutrient ratios over the entire mediterranean that starts at the gibraltar straits and through the western basin proceeds to the ionian and levantine seas supply of nutrients to the

entire mediterranean is limited by inputs from the north atlantic and various river systems along the sea the unique feature of the mediterranean is the presence of an eastward longitudinal trend in available nitrate phosphate ratios this apparently induces a west to east variation in the structure of the pelagic food web and trophic interactions in this context the mediterranean and in particular its eastern basin provides probably a unique platform to explore the hypotheses related to the suggested phosphate limitation on production and to the shift between microbial and classical modes of operation of the photic food web the major exception of the overall oligotrophic nature of the eastern mediterranean is the highly eutrophic system of the northern adriatic sea here during the last two decades the discharges of the northern rivers especially of the po together with municipal sewage have led to a very marked increase of nutrients and subsequent imponent eutrophication events

the west is popularly perceived as america s last outpost of unfettered opportunity but twentieth century corporate tourism has transformed it into america s land of opportunism from sun valley to santa fe towns throughout the west have been turned over to outsiders and not just to those who visit and move on but to those who stay and control although tourism has been a blessing for many bringing economic and cultural prosperity to communities without obvious means of support or allowing towns on the brink of extinction to renew themselves the costs on more intangible levels may be said to outweigh the benefits and be a devil s bargain in the making hal rothman examines the effect of twentieth century tourism on the west and exposes that industry s darker side he tells how tourism evolved from grand canyon rail trips to sun valley ski weekends and disneyland vacations and how the post world war ii boom in air travel and luxury hotels capitalized on a surge in discretionary income for many americans combined with newfound leisure time from major destinations like las vegas to revitalized towns like aspen and moab rothman reveals how the introduction of tourism into a community may seem innocuous but residents gradually realize as they seek to preserve the authenticity of their communities that decision making power has subtly shifted from the community itself to the newly arrived corporate

financiers and because tourism often results in a redistribution of wealth and power to outsiders observes rothman it represents a new form of colonialism for the region by depicting the nature of tourism in the american west through true stories of places and individuals that have felt its grasp rothman doesn t just document the effects of tourism but provides us with an enlightened explanation of the shape these changes take deftly balancing historical perspective with an eye for what s happening in the region right now his book sets new standards for the study of tourism and is one that no citizen of the west whose life is touched by that industry can afford to ignore

branded a cultural chernobyl and the tragic kingdom the euro disney resort has been on its own thrill ride since opening in 1992 the much publicized version of the magic kingdom gave europeans alcohol free mocktails surly employees even colors too muted for the disney image facing financial disaster was it any wonder that disney execs found themselves wishing upon a star for answers after so many knee jerk criticisms of euro disney this book combines firsthand experience and research to shed new light on claims that the park is nothing more than a form of american cultural imperialism andrew lainsbury a former euro disney employee who knows what the park meant to its visitors goes beyond media bites and academic scorn to examine europe s love hate relationship with euro disneyland and some of the undiscussed issues surrounding it once upon an american dream is a story of global capitalism on a grand scale lainsbury has plumbed company archives and interviewed key players to give readers the real view from le chateau de la belle au bois dormant sleeping beauty s castle he cracks open the euro disney controversy to reveal the park not as a tragic experiment in exporting american culture but the result of european efforts to import a popular form of american entertainment lainsbury tells how the walt disney company came to build a european park and locate it in france how political negotiations affected its design and development how it was promoted to continental audiences and what caused its widely publicized financial woes before being rescued by a real prince from saudi arabia he reveals what it took to win back the hearts of skeptical europeans such as serving wine selling flashy merchandise and placating disgruntled workers finally he looks into the magic mirror to speculate on the role of euro disney and the walt disney company in the twenty first century ultimately lainsbury shows that cultural imperialism is not an exclusively american phenomenon but a global corporate strategy and that global corporatism by needing to be responsive to consumers is so complex that it may not be as monolithic as feared once upon an american dream is a fairy tale for our times reminding us that for all the critical huffing and puffing the creation and marketing of pleasure is what euro disneyland is all about

it is becoming common in many states the opportunity to reclaim government from politicians by simply signing a petition to put an initiative on the ballot and then voting for it isn't this what america ought to be about proposition 13 in california's 1978 election paved the way the past decade saw more than 450 such actions now in many states direct legislation dominates the political agenda and defines political and public opinion while this may appear to be democracy in action richard ellis warns us that the initiative process may be putting democracy at risk in democratic delusions he offers a critical analysis of the statewide initiative process in the united states challenging readers to look beyond populist rhetoric and face political reality through engaging prose and illuminating and often amusing anecdotes ellis shows readers the dark side of direct democracy specifically the undemocratic consequences that result from relying too heavily on the initiative process he provides historic context to the development of initiatives from their populist and progress roots to their accelerated use in recent decades and shows the differences between initiative processes in the states that use them most important while acknowledging the positive contribution of initiatives ellis shows that there are reasons to use them carefully and sparingly ill considered initiatives can subvert normal legislative checks and balances undermine the deliberative process and even threaten the rights of minority groups through state sanctioned measures today's initiative process ellis warns is dominated not by ordinary citizens but by politicians perennial activists wealthy interests and well oiled machines deliberately misleading language on the ballot confuses voters and influences election results and because many initiatives are challenged in the courts these ostensibly democratic

procedures have now put legislation in the hands of the judiciary throughout his book he cites examples drawn from states in which initiatives are used intensively oregon california colorado washington and arizona as well as others in which their use has increased in recent years undoing mistakes enacted by initiative can be more difficult than correcting errors of legislatures as voters prepare to consider the host of initiatives that will be offered in the 2002 elections this book can help put those efforts in a clearer light democratic delusions urges moderation attempting to teach citizens to be at least as skeptical of the initiative process as they are of the legislative process and to appreciate the enduring value of the representative institutions they seek to circumvent

through much of the 1990s a newly hatched snake wreaked political havoc in the south when north carolina gained a seat in congress following the 1990 census it sought to rectify a long standing failure to represent african american voters by creating under federal pressure two majority minority voting districts one of these snaked along interstate 85 for nearly two hundred miles not much wider than the road itself in some places and was ridiculed by many as one of the least compact legislative districts ever proposed from 1993 to 2001 three intertwined cases went before the supreme court that decided how far a state could go in establishing voting districts along racial lines noted supreme court biographer tinsley yarbrough examines these closely linked landmark cases to show how the court addressed the constitutionality of redistricting within the volatile contexts of civil rights and partisan politics a suit was first filed by duke university law professor robinson everett a liberal who loathed discrimination but considered racially motivated redistricting a clear violation of the fourteenth amendment's equal protection clause yarbrough tells how everett enlisted associates as plaintiffs and went on to win two supreme court victories in shaw v reno 1993 and shaw v hunt 1996 both by 5-4 decisions following the creation of another flawed redistricting plan he rounded up a new set of plaintiffs to take the battle back to the supreme court but this time in easley v cromartie on the swing vote of justice sandra day o'connor the 5-4 vote went against him yarbrough shows the significant impact these cases have had on election law and the fascinating interplay of law politics and human conflict that the dispute generated drawing heavily on court records and on interviews with attorneys on both sides of the litigation he relates a complex and intriguing tale about these protracted struggles his cogent and balanced analysis considers whether the state legislature was wrong in using race as a measure for establishing the new district or whether it was simply engaging in the time honored practice of gerrymandering to ensure political balance race and redistricting spotlights efforts to racially engineer voting districts in an effort to achieve fair representation by examining one state's efforts to confront such dilemmas it helps

readers better understand future disputes over race and politics as well as the ongoing debates over our color blind constitution
